SAVING THE LIVES OF CRITICALLY ILL BABIES

£111,800

Thanks to a wide range of donors and funders, we have been able to fund a new ambulance incubator trolley, helping to save the lives of more critically ill babies.



A NEW LIFE-SAVING KIDNEY BIOPSY SERVICE

£24,500

A new digital pathology service aims to standardise and speed up viability assessment, increasing the number of organs available for successful transplant, saving lives & dialysis costs.



SUPPORTING RESEARCH INTO PARKINSON'S DISEASE

£335,000

ACT granted funding to support young researchers in their study of Parkinson's disease and its causes, which could help in diagnosis and the search for new treatments.



PIONEERING RESEARCH INTO NON-HODGKIN LYMPHOMA

£34,400

Funding new research into how hundreds of the most common mutations react to therapy; moving towards highly effective, individualised treatments for non-Hodgkin lymphoma.



LIFE-ENHANCING PAEDIATRIC ULTRASOUND MACHINE

£22,995

Allows the most accurate and effective targeting of injections for children with cerebral palsy and arthritis; reducing pain, swelling and muscle contraction, greatly enhancing their quality of life.



GROUND-BREAKING STUDIES INTO NEW TREATMENTS FOR VIRUSES

£24,416

Dormant viruses are immune to treatment, but this new study has discovered the means to reactivate a virus so that it may be treated, leading to possible new therapies and cures.

£11,500

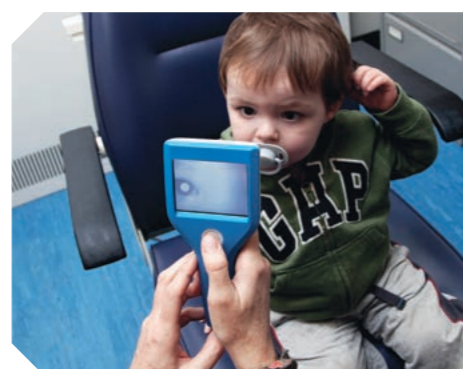
Your donations have allowed us to invest in beautiful new wall art for the Radiotherapy waiting room, helping to make it a more welcoming environment for our radiotherapy patients.

Neocam is an innovative new device to more accurately detect cataracts and eye cancer in babies and infants. Our grant helped develop the prototype and secure onward funding.



ESTABLISHING A HEALTH PARTNERSHIP IN THE PHILIPPINES

£10,000

Cambridge Global Health Partnerships is working with partners in the Philippines to help improve access to safe, affordable surgery and anaesthesia, while creating opportunities for mutual learning.
